




55 families responded with a population of 255 under 18 year old's in Hay means that we had a return of 21.5% which is classed as a good return with reliable results.

How often do you (or your children) use the play equipment? 54 responses




Which playground do you use the most?




What do you especially like and dislike at The Recreation Facilities? Variety of answers compiled by appeared most often including Lack of play for younger ones


What do you especially like and dislike at Gipsy Castle? Variety of answers compiled by appeared most often including Designed for under 7's so older ones find it boring Needs a refurb

Children like "pretend play". Would you want to see additional play equipment that encourages imaginative play?



What sort of activities does your young person enjoy the most? 55 responses




Thinking of Climbing / Scrambling items would you like to see any of the following: 55 responses




Thinking Games, would you like to see any of the following:


Thinking smaller children, would you like to see any of the following:






Thinking about the play areas, is it important that children of different ages can play together 52 responses



Which type of playground surface would you prefer? 52 responses




Would the play areas benefit from additional seating?

Some news for you from Dial-a-Ride over the summer!

I have placed the order for the new minibus, which is due for delivery in summer 2024. This will replace the existing larger minibus which has been in service since 2014. We still have about £20k to raise (the bus will cost approx £65k).

Our membership levels have increased to 330 now, which is the highest it has ever been. We are still looking for community car drivers, ideally living within or close to Hay, but I won't be recruiting any more minibus drivers until the Spring of next year. This is because we are still working on training the existing two cohorts of new volunteers.

Our AGM is to be held at 3pm on Tuesday 17th October and we'd like to invite you to attend. If you can confirm you want to come, I'll arrange to get a set of papers to you.

We are celebrating Community Transport week in October (16th to 22nd) by spotlighting our service and volunteers in action on our Facebook page. I'd like to invite you to come along on the bus on the Thursday morning to meet some of our regular passengers and see what they think of our service.
